## Let's play!

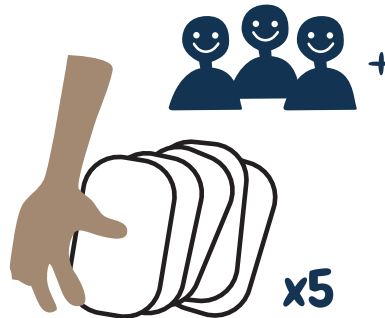
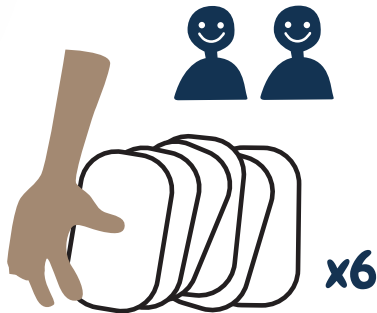
- 1 Cut out the dominoes.



- 2 Place the dominoes face down on the table and mix them up.

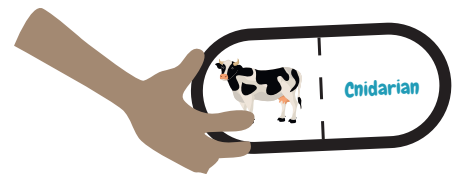


- 3 If there are two players, each player will take 6 dominoes, if there are more players, each player will take 5 dominoes. Players must not see each other's counters.



The remaining dominoes are left on the table facing downwards.

- 4 The first player will place one of his dominoes face up on the table.



- 5 The next player places another domino that matches the domino placed by the first player.

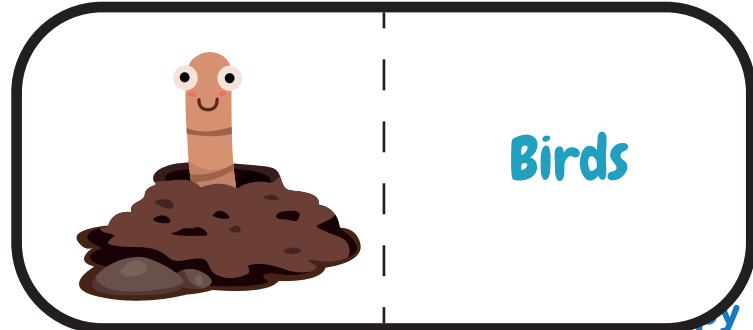
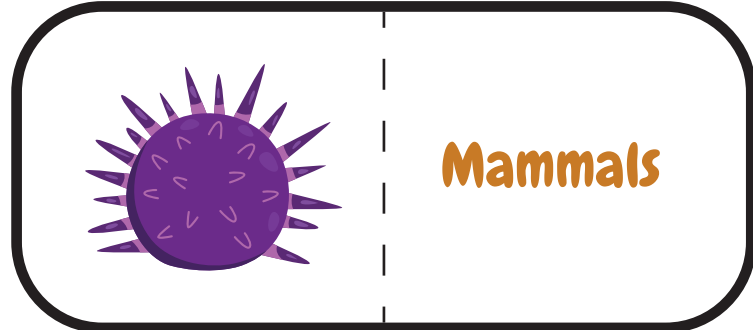
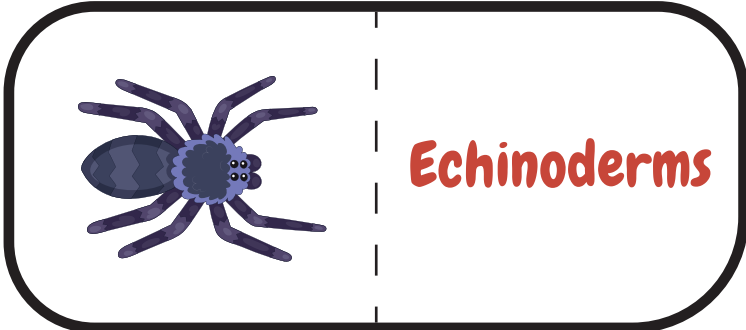
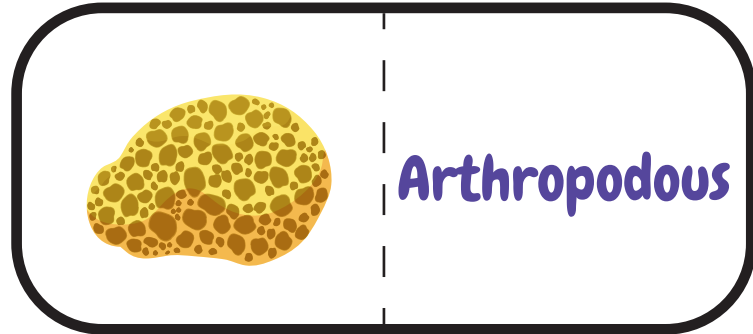
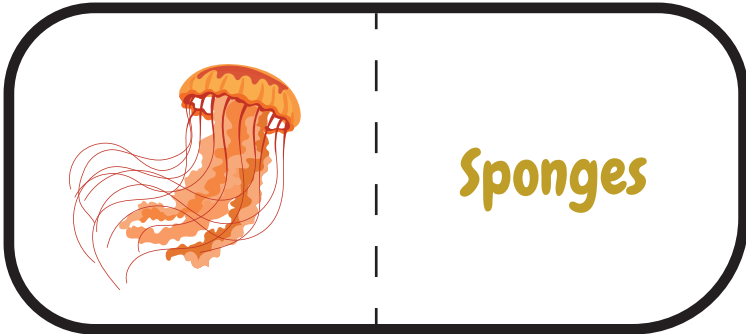
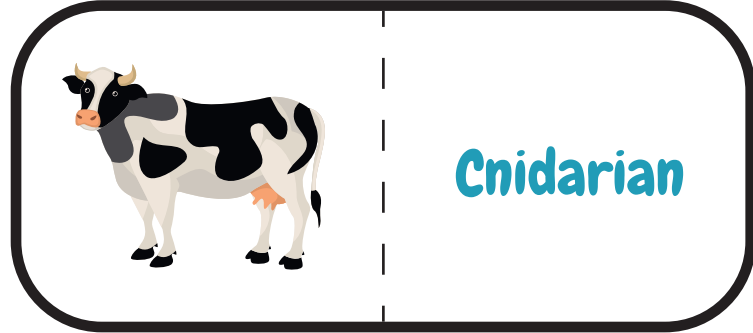
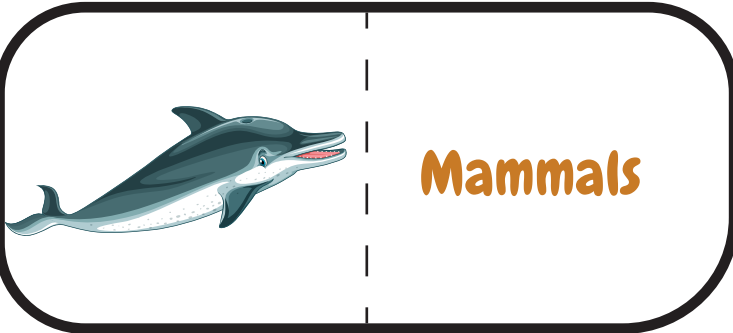
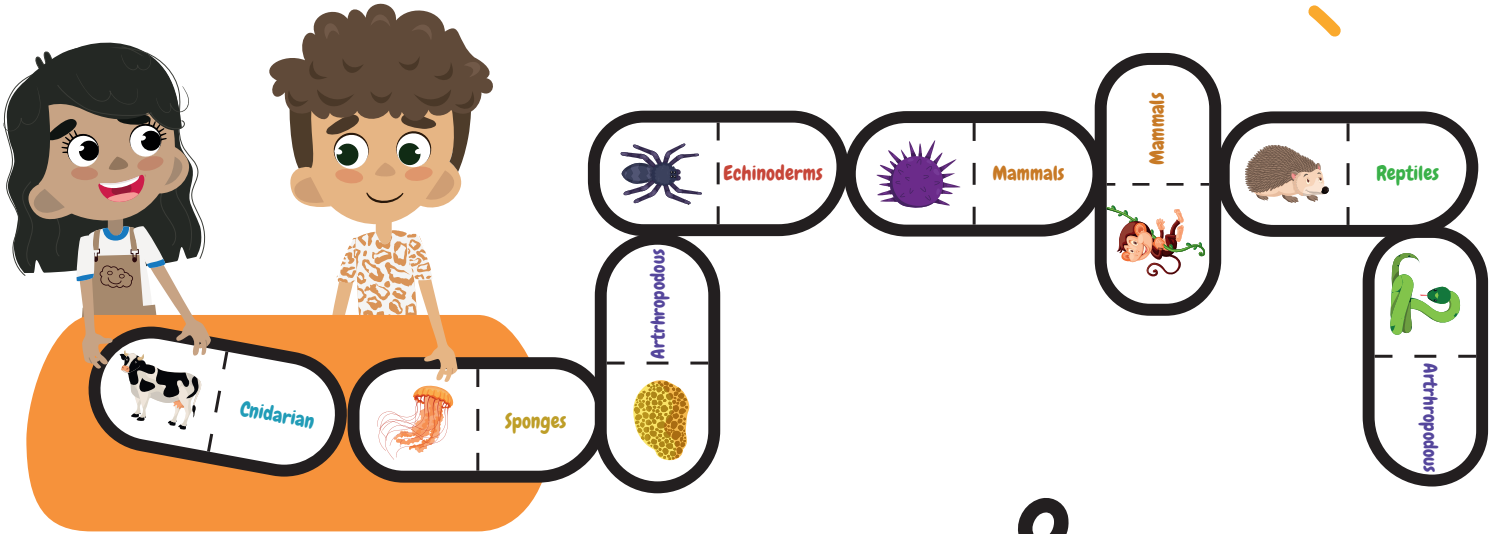


If you do not have a matching domino, you must take another from the table and let

the next player have their turn. If you do not have a domino to place, draw one from the pile. If that one isn't valid either, pass the turn to the next player.

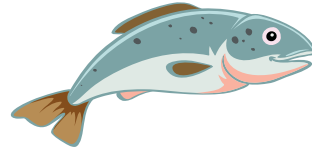
- 6 A chain will form like the one you see on the next page.
